# Care instructions

### Leather clothing

### General tips for the proper handling / cleaning of leather

Products made of leather or textiles with leather trim: After each use, air the clothing well and remove dirt using a soft brush and clean water. Do not store products in airtight plastic bags. Never treat leather with solvents or chemical agents, do not wash in washing machine or spin dry, only hand wash with lukewarm water with leather detergent is recommended. Dry products with leather at room temperature (avoid direct sunlight, heating or hair dryer).

Leather care: In order to prevent natural aging of leather or products processed with leather (formation of cracks, brittle surface, decrease in resistance or waterproofness, etc.) we recommend treating our products with care products. Please note that the treatment may slightly change the appearance of the original leather, but the functionality and positive properties of the leather will not be affected, but only improved by proper care.

Attention: Leather may lose some color and the soft feel when washed.

### Textile clothing

### General tips for the proper handling / cleaning of textile materials

Held products made of textile materials: To prolong the life of textile fibers and fabrics of a product, the product should be cleaned regularly. Held textile materials can be washed in your washing machine without hesitation: Pay attention to the washing label! Unless otherwise indicated, wash at 30 °C; please use only mild detergent, no fabric softener. Please only fill the drum of the washing machine halfway.

IMPORTANT: Integrated protectors (shoulder/elbow as well as special foam or back CE protectors must be removed before washing. Avoid intensive rinsing processes as well as "spinning".

Basic tips for handling textile impregnating agents: After use, air the clothing well as well as remove any dirt with a soft brush and clear water. The fabric must be clean and slightly damp. Impregnation should be done only after washing. Please treat your product only outdoors or in well-ventilated rooms. The impregnation effect develops best after heat treatment by means of a dryer: approved maximum temperature see care label, hair dryer: 10 -15 minutes at 20 - 30 cm distance, iron: Level 2, cotton towel underneath. Repeat impregnation according to the number as well as duration of rainy trips.

You should impregnate your textile clothing after every wash to restore the natural beading effect of the outer fabric

#### Gloves

### General tips for proper handling / cleaning of leather gloves

All unlined gloves are exposed to natural, aggressive skin perspiration, especially in the palm and fingertip areas. This hardens the leather until it breaks. Held gloves are equipped sweat-proof, but you can still extend the life of your glove by proper leather care.

- 01. Wash gloves in lukewarm water with soap or a special leather cleaning agent.
- O2. To avoid detergent residues, rinse sufficiently clear (repeat rinse cycle)
- 03. Wrap in dry cloth and pre-dry by squeezing, do not wring, do not knead
- 04. Air dry gloves (no heating, sun or dryer)
- 05. Do not use fabric softener
- 06. In semi-moist state, put glove on and clench fist to bring glove back into shape
- 07. Put on dry glove and knead softly
- 08. Treat with a leather care product

## General tips for proper handling / cleaning of textile as well as membrane gloves

- 09. Wash gloves by hand with very mild washing powder
- To avoid detergent residues, rinse sufficiently clear (repeat rinse cycle)
- 11. Do not wring out wet gloves, do not knead them
- 12. Air dry gloves (no heating, sun or dryer)
- 13. Do not use bleach or fabric softener
- 14. Do not dry clean

If only the inner lining is to be washed, in the case of membrane gloves this can be washed with a little water and a small amount of mild detergent without getting the outer glove (leather or textile etc.) wet.



#### Helmets

### General tips for the proper handling / cleaning of motorcycle helmets

Helmet outer shell: clean the helmet shell regularly with a neutral, lukewarm soapy water or a scratch-free microfiber cloth and let the helmet air dry (keep it away from heat sources). Polish the helmet with a soft cloth. Avoid contact of the helmet with substances containing solvents such as paints, adhesives or fuel.

**Visor:** To make it easier to remove insect remains and other dirt, you should clean the visor regularly - ideally after each use. Use a soft cloth and lukewarm water, or lukewarm soapy water or dishwashing detergent. Dry the visor with a soft cloth (never use a hair dryer). Under no circumstances should you use visor cleaners, glass cleaners, window sprays or solvents. These can damage the coating of the visor and the plastic surface of the visor mechanism!

If stubborn dirt residues need to be removed, leave the wet cloth on the visor for some time until the dirt has dissolved.

Removable inner lining and cheek pads: Remove cheek pads and inner lining and wash with mild detergent or hair shampoo in lukewarm water and rinse with clear water. Then squeeze gently and allow to air dry. Never use a washing machine or tumble dryer!

Non-removable inner lining and cheek pads: wash with hand-warm soapy water and then gently squeeze out with clear water using a sponge and allow to air dry.

### Used parts

### General tips for the proper handling / cleaning of used parts

In case of hooking metal zippers, make them functional with candle wax, pencil lead or oil.

Plastic zippers are maintenance-free..

### **Impregnation**

Well impregnated products are dirt and water repellent.

A soaked outer material causes heat loss. A good impregnation therefore also protects against cold. The outer fabrics are already impregnated during production. Since the impregnation loses its effect over time (when the water no longer beads off the outer fabric), products should be treated with a common impregnation spray.
